

USING THE RIGHT TOOLS AT THE RIGHT TIME SAVES YOU FROM BACKACHES AND SAVES YOU TIME!



STORAGE BUCKET

Use proper storage for salt to avoid exposure to moisture, clumping, spillage, and damage to building infrastructure.



ICE SCRAPER/ CHISEL

Use to remove compaction. Flexible blade scraper is used to go under the ice. Ice chisel is rigid and is used to break through the ice.



WALK OFF MAT

Place at entryways to absorb water and prevent slippery surfaces.



HANDHELD SALT SPREADER

Use in larger entryway. Helps distribute salts evenly. Minimizes waste.



TRACTION FOOTWEAR

Use proper footwear to minimize slips and falls



SALT SHAKER

Use in smaller areas where a broadcast spreader might distribute salt into grass. Helps distribute salt more evenly.



THERMOMETER

Check temperature and weather for the right materials, tools and process to match the situation.



WALK BEHIND SPREADER

Good for applying on wide walkways.



SCOOP SHOVEL

Good for lifting and moving snow. Good for working in small spaces.



PUSH SHOVEL

Good for guiding and sliding snow on the ground. Generally, you can move more snow faster.



LIQUID TANK SPRAYER

Use to apply anti-icing liquid before a storm.
